PRIVATAIR PARTICIPATES IN AIRBUS CHARITY CHALLENGE

PrivatAir, pleased to associate itself with Airbus' charity challenge, provided transportation for a group of passengers from Broughton to Paris and return last weekend, enabling the group of some 80 children to spend the day at EuroDisney in Paris.

The Charity Challenge initiative began in 1989 and has so far raised over £1.2 million for various not-for-profit organizations. On this particular trip, Airbus, in cooperation with its partners, organized a trip for 80 children between the ages of 9 and 16 years from nearby National Children's Homes to visit EuroDisney for a day. The flight departed from Chester at 8am, arriving in Paris 70 minutes later. The return flight left PrivatAir's Le Bourget facilities at 8pm, giving the passengers a full day's worth of excitement in the theme park.

For this trip, one of PrivatAir's 126-seat A319 aircraft was used – one of two A319 normally operated by PrivatAir on behalf on the Airbus Group transporting personnel between its production sites of Hamburg, Toulouse, and Filton (GB) on a daily basis.
